1. Introduction & Program Overview

The Lakh Bangles Making Training Program, implemented by Care For Smile Foundation with the support of the Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI), stands as a transformative livelihood initiative aimed at empowering women and adolescent girls in Ghaziabad. The program is a vital component of a broader Livelihood-Oriented Skill Development Programme, focusing on enhancing income-generating opportunities for women from economically disadvantaged backgrounds.

Lal Kuan, Ghaziabad and its surrounding regions, though rich in cultural heritage, face **persistent socio-economic challenges**. Many women in these communities are caught in a cycle of **poverty, seasonal employment, limited educational access, and lack of vocational training**. These constraints often prevent them from contributing meaningfully to household incomes, thus reinforcing **financial dependency and social marginalization**.

This project was designed as a **targeted intervention** to tackle these issues by providing **market-relevant**, **skill-based training** in the traditional art of **Lakh Bangles Making**—a craft with both cultural significance and strong market demand. The program offered a **sustainable solution** by blending traditional craftsmanship with modern entrepreneurial guidance and market linkages.

Through structured training modules, 200 women and adolescent girls were trained across two programs. The curriculum included traditional and contemporary bangle-making techniques, quality control practices, design development, and market insights. Additionally, financial literacy, soft skills, and entrepreneurship development sessions were integrated to prepare participants for both employment and self-employment pathways.

The training also emphasized **entrepreneurial empowerment**, encouraging women to set up **micro-enterprises or self-help groups (SHGs)**. Participants were introduced to **Udyam registration**, credit linkages, and mentorship opportunities to help them navigate the journey from skill acquisition to sustainable livelihood generation.

This initiative successfully addressed not only the need for **vocational skill enhancement**, but also the deeper goal of **enabling socio-economic inclusion**. By equipping participants with practical skills, boosting their confidence, and connecting them to real-world opportunities, the program has paved the way for **financial independence and improved quality of life** for women in underserved communities.

With the successful completion of both programs and significant employment and entrepreneurship outcomes, this project marks a **significant step toward inclusive development** and women-led economic empowerment in the region.

2. Program Objectives

The Lakh Bangles Making Training Program, implemented by Care For Smile Foundation with the support of Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI), was designed with a clear vision to address livelihood challenges and empower women through skill-based employment opportunities. The key objectives of the program were as follows:

1. Skill Development for Sustainable Livelihoods

To equip women and adolescent girls from underprivileged backgrounds with practical skills in **Lakh Bangles Making**, enabling them to pursue gainful employment or self-employment opportunities.

2. Economic Empowerment of Women

To promote **financial independence** among women by providing them with income-generating skills, reducing their dependency on seasonal or informal labor, and contributing to household income stability.

3. Promotion of Traditional Craft

To preserve and promote the **traditional art of Lakh Bangle Making**, which is not only culturally significant but also a high-potential sector for employment and entrepreneurship in local markets.

4. Encouragement of Entrepreneurship

To encourage and support participants in setting up **small-scale bangle production units or shops** by providing training in business planning, Udyam registration, marketing strategies, and access to credit linkages.

5. Holistic Development through Soft Skills and Guidance

To build the **overall capacity of participants** by integrating soft skills training, placement preparation, and entrepreneurship guidance into the program, ensuring better employability and business sustainability.

6. Long-Term Social Impact

To contribute towards **gender equality, poverty alleviation, and inclusive development** by creating skill-based livelihood models that can be replicated and scaled in other regions.

3. Strategy to Onboard Participants

A well-structured and community-centric strategy was adopted to onboard participants for the Lakh Bangles Making Training Program. The aim was to reach out to women and adolescent girls from marginalized and economically weaker sections of society, ensuring inclusive participation and maximum outreach.

The following multi-pronged approach was undertaken to mobilize and onboard the participants effectively:

1. Community Engagement and Outreach Drives

- **Door-to-door campaigns** were conducted in urban slums and rural settlements to identify interested and eligible women and girls.
- Community leaders, local influencers, and women self-help groups were sensitized about the program and encouraged to spread awareness within their networks.
- Awareness sessions were held at Anganwadi centers, government schools, local NGOs, Panchayat Bhawans, and community halls to reach potential participants directly.

2. Collaboration with Local Stakeholders

- Partnerships were built with local NGOs, women welfare organizations, and social workers who supported participant identification and mobilization.
- Existing women SHGs and micro-enterprise clusters were leveraged to identify motivated individuals seeking livelihood opportunities.

3. Information Dissemination through IEC Activities

- **Posters, pamphlets, banners, and street announcements** were used in targeted areas to inform and encourage participation.
- **Interactive orientation meetings** and small group discussions were organized to explain the program's benefits, training structure, duration, and placement/entrepreneurship support.

4. Transparent Enrollment Process

- Interested participants were guided to fill out a **simple enrollment form** capturing essential information such as their background, interest in skill development, availability, and personal aspirations.
- This helped streamline communication and created a database for tracking the journey of each participant throughout the training.

4. Training Details

The Lakh Bangles Making Training Program, implemented by CARE FOR SMILE Foundation with support from SIDBI, was designed to deliver structured, practical, and market-relevant skill training to women and adolescent girls from marginalized communities in Ghaziabad. The training was implemented in **two programs**, each comprising **100 participants**, totaling **200 trained beneficiaries** under the project.



Program-wise Training Timeline:

Each group was trained in smaller, interactive programs to ensure **focused attention**, **hands-on practice**, and **personalized mentoring**. The program division was done to ensure better time management, space utilization, and learning efficiency.

Training Curriculum:

The training program was structured to balance both theoretical learning and practical skills development to ensure comprehensive knowledge acquisition and job-readiness.

Key components included:

- Material selection and preparation
- Traditional and modern techniques of bangle crafting
- Decorative art and finishing methods
- Quality control and safety measures
- Design conceptualization and execution
- Maintenance of tools and equipment
- Financial literacy and business management basics
- Udyam registration awareness
- Product pricing and market linkages

Practical Training Approach:

The practical training sessions were designed with a **step-by-step approach**, enabling participants to gradually build their expertise across all facets of Lakh Bangle Making. Each stage of the curriculum was delivered with hands-on demonstrations, practice modules, and expert guidance to ensure the development of fine craftsmanship.

Participants received **comprehensive exposure to various styles of bangles**, ranging from **traditional ethnic designs to modern fashion-centric patterns**, aligning their skills with current market demands and preferences.

Sketching and Design Principles Sessions:

The **Sketching and Design Principles sessions** were a core aspect of the training. These sessions enhanced participants' creativity, helping them visualize their designs on paper and experiment with different styles before execution. This practice helped improve their understanding of both basic and advanced design concepts.

These lessons served not only as a **creative outlet for self-expression** but also laid the groundwork for **potential entrepreneurial ventures**. Participants learned how to conceptualize unique, marketable designs, enabling them to differentiate their products in the competitive handicraft market.

Training Methodology:

- **Hands-on Practice:** Real-time practice under expert trainers to build practical expertise.
- **Demonstration Sessions:** Regular live demonstrations with models and prototypes.
- **Group Learning:** Peer collaboration and teamwork to encourage mutual learning.
- Exposure to Market Trends: Guest lectures and sessions by industry professionals.
- Assessment & Feedback: Regular evaluation and improvement feedback cycles.

Training Infrastructure:

The training center was well-equipped with:

- Workstations and specialized tools for practice
- Raw material and design kits
- Sketching materials and visual aids
- Comfortable seating and teaching support

By the end of the training, each participant was equipped with both technical craftsmanship and creative capabilities, ready to step into employment or launch their own ventures. The quality of their handmade bangles displayed at the culmination of the training was a powerful testament to the skill enhancement achieved under this program and the participants' potential to contribute to the local economy and artisan industry meaningfully.

5. Program Flow and Key Milestones

The Lakh Bangles Making Training Program, implemented by CARE FOR SMILE Foundation with the support of Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI), followed a structured and phased approach to ensure effective delivery, skill enhancement, and

sustainable livelihood generation for women and adolescent girls from economically disadvantaged backgrounds in Ghaziabad.

The program's flow was strategically designed from mobilization to post-training support, ensuring that participants were not only skilled but also supported with employment avenues and entrepreneurial guidance.

1. Project Planning and Community Mobilization (May – June 2024)

- Detailed program planning, resource allocation, curriculum development, and trainer selection.
- Community mobilization campaigns including door-to-door outreach, awareness drives, community meetings, and SHG group engagement.
- Identification of target beneficiaries based on socio-economic background and interest in skill-based livelihoods.

2. Participant Onboarding and Selection Process

- Registrations were conducted through local outreach programs, community announcements, and local NGO support.
- Orientation sessions were held to explain training benefits, structure, and career pathways.
- Selection criteria included economic vulnerability, willingness to learn, and intent to pursue livelihood opportunities.
- A total of **200 participants** (**100 per program**) were selected and divided into **Group A** and **Group B** for structured training sessions.

3. Program-wise Training Implementation

First Program:

• **Duration:** 15th June 2024 – 15th August 2024

Second Program:

• **Duration:** 15th January 2025 – 15th March 2025

4. Employment Training and Placement Facilitation

- Dedicated sessions were conducted to prepare participants for employment:
 - o Soft skills development
 - o Interview readiness and workplace behavior
 - Resume writing and business pitching for entrepreneurs
- Placement Support:

- CFS collaborated with local bangle-making units and handicraft-based enterprises to identify job opportunities.
- o **On-site interviews** and employment interaction sessions were organized with various organizations and entrepreneurs in the handicraft industry.
- Hands-on exposure and field visits provided practical insights into real work environments.

5. Post-Training Assessment and Review

- Evaluation of skills through practical assessments and creative design demonstrations.
- Trainers assessed each participant's readiness for employment or self-employment.
- Guidance was provided on product pricing, cost control, and small business management.

6. Employment Support & SHG Engagement

- 136 participants (68%) are currently engaged in wage-based work, small business ventures, or home-based production.
- First Program:
 - 52 participants secured employment in various organizations.
 - o 20 participants chose the path of self-employment and have also been registered on the Udyam Portal.
- Second Program:
 - 35 candidates have been placed in bangle-making organizations.
 - o 29 participants have been organized into a Self-Help Group (SHG) and registered on the Udyam Portal.

Support for SHG by Care For Smile Foundation (CFS):

- Machinery and Infrastructure: CFS is providing necessary equipment and infrastructure support to SHG members as per their convenience.
- Market Linkage: CFS is assisting in marketing and selling their handmade products through local markets and exhibitions.
- Employment within CFS: SHG members have also been hired by CFS for regular work and receive monthly payments based on their contribution.

7. Post-Program Mentorship and Market Linkages

- Continued support for all participants in accessing markets, exhibitions, fairs, and ecommerce platforms.
- CFS remains in **regular contact with other candidates** who are still seeking employment or wish to start their own ventures, helping them find the right opportunities and build their dream careers.
- The training outcomes are being continuously monitored to ensure long-term impact and sustainability.

6. Program Impact and Achievements

The Lakh Bangles Making Training Program, implemented by CARE FOR SMILE Foundation with the support of Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI), has made a remarkable impact on the lives of women and adolescent girls in Ghaziabad. The initiative has successfully contributed to skill development, economic empowerment, and livelihood generation among women from marginalized communities.

Key Achievements at a Glance:

- **Total Beneficiaries Trained:** 200 women and adolescent girls (100 in each program).
- Employment Outcomes:
 - First Program: 52 participants successfully secured employment in reputed organizations, while 20 participants pursued self-employment and have been registered on the Udyam Portal to formalize their entrepreneurial journey.
 - Second Program: 35 participants have been placed in Lakh Bangle-making workshops and enterprises. Additionally, 29 women from this program have been organized into a Self-Help Group (SHG) to facilitate sustainable employment in Lakh Bangle-making. The SHG is currently undergoing registration on the Udyam Portal to initiate group-based economic activities.
 - Total Employment & Earning Participants: 136 out of 200, achieving an overall employment rate of 68%.

Entrepreneurship & Group Formation: 11 LE

- A Self-Help Group (SHG) of 29 women has been formed to provide structured support for lakh bangle-making as an economic activity.
- CARE FOR SMILE Foundation is extending infrastructure and machinery support to this SHG and is also assisting them with marketing and selling their handmade products.
- CFS has engaged SHG members in some of its regular activities and will provide them with monthly remuneration based on their work duration, ensuring steady income opportunities.
- This initiative has created a **dual pathway—formal placements and entrepreneurial self-reliance**—for beneficiaries to achieve financial independence.

Skill Development & Industry Readiness:

 Participants received comprehensive hands-on training in Lakh Bangle Making, including contemporary designs, quality control, and finishing techniques.

- CARE FOR SMILE Foundation will continue to provide guidance and support to all remaining participants who are yet to secure employment or are aspiring to start their own businesses.
- Regular mentorship and handholding support are being provided to help each participant reach their full potential.

Broader Social Impact:

- Strengthened self-confidence and community standing among women beneficiaries.
- Encouragement of home-based income-generating activities.
- Promotion of **traditional artisan skills** as a means of economic empowerment.
- Establishment of a replicable model for women-centric livelihood development.
